# Our Plan for Personal Development

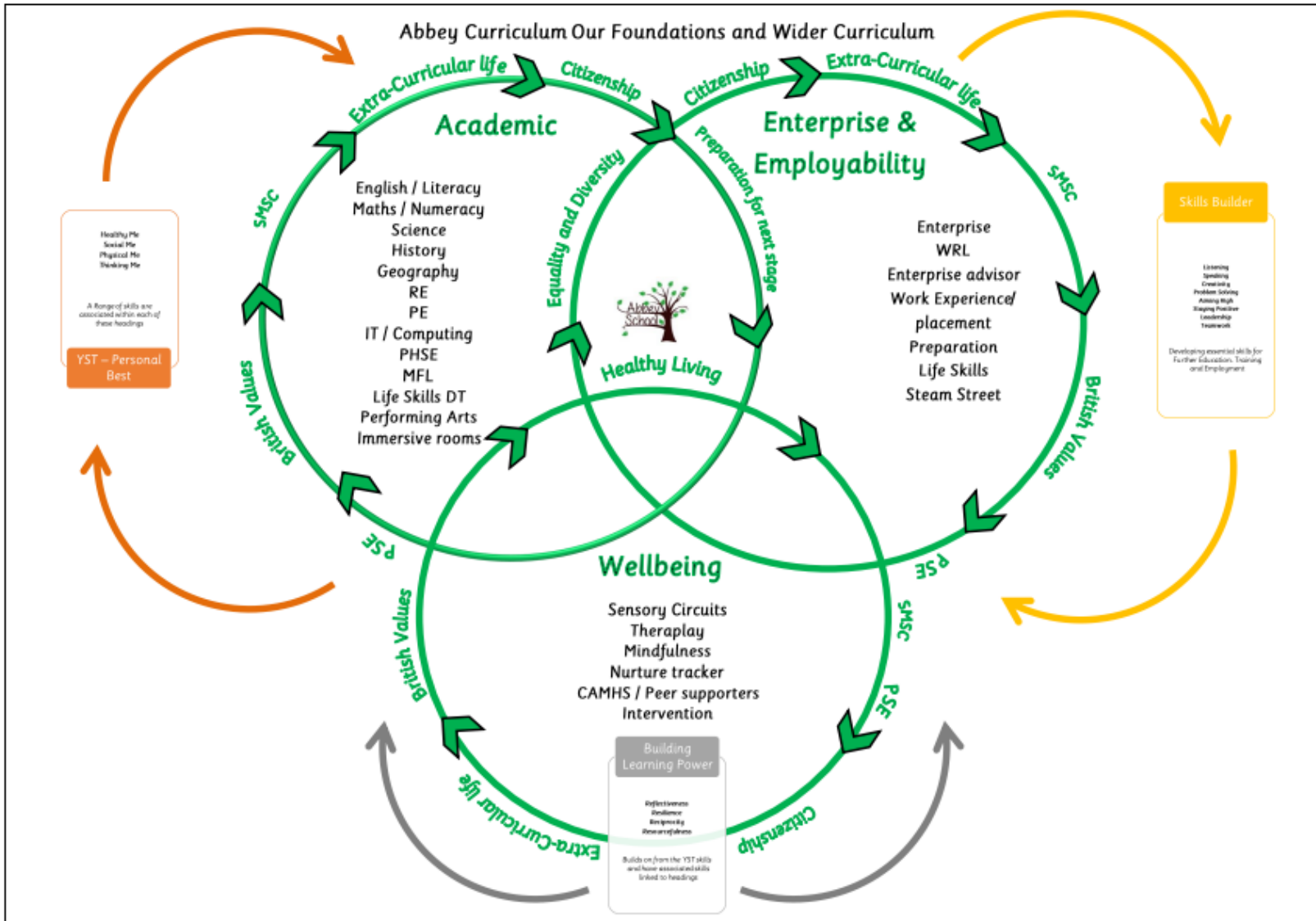

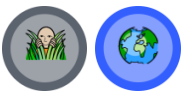
